

# Adding an Infant to an Existing Alaska Airlines Reservation: A Complete Guide

Alaska Airlines Infant Addition: Just a Call Away from Support How to Add a Lap Infant to Your Alaska Airlines Reservation

To add a lap infant to your Alaska Airlines reservation, visit the official website and book your flight. Under the "Travelers" section, select the number of passengers. Choose "Infants (Under 2)" if you want to purchase a seat for your child, or select "Infants on Lap" if you prefer not to buy a ticket. For assistance, you can call Alaska Airlines customer service at +1-800-223-7138 (OTA). If traveling internationally, ensure your child has a valid passport.

## Traveling with Twins on Alaska Airlines

Alaska Airlines allows the first adult on the reservation to sit with up to two children under 12 for free. If you're traveling with twins, the first adult can sit with both. It's advisable to coordinate with a travel professional at +1-800-223-7138 (OTA). After booking, you can select seats in "My Trips." If flying solo with two infants, you'll need to purchase an additional seat for one. For more details, call +1-855-5465598 (OTA).

## Confirming a Lap Infant Booking

To confirm a lap infant booking, contact Alaska Airlines at +1-800-223-7138 (OTA) or add the infant during the online booking process. Provide the infant's date of birth and any required documents. For existing reservations, you can update your booking through your Alaska Airlines account or call customer service for assistance.

## Adding a Lap Infant to a Basic Economy Ticket

Adding a lap infant to a basic Alaska Airlines economy ticket is typically free. However, international flights may incur fees, which you can confirm by calling +1-800-223-7138 (OTA). Children under two can sit on a parent's lap, and you may bring an approved car seat for your infant. For more information, reach out to a travel expert at +1-855-546-5598 (OTA).

## Lap Infants in Premium Cabins

Yes, Alaska Airlines allows lap infants in premium cabins, including Premium Plus and Polaris. Specific seating restrictions may apply, so inform the airline when booking. Additional fees may be required for international routes. For more details, call +1-800-223-7138 (OTA).

#### Flexible Ticket Options for Infants

Alaska Airlines offers flexible ticket options for infants if you purchase a separate seat. These tickets may include change and refund flexibility. Lap infant policies vary by route and fare class, so confirm your options by contacting Alaska Airlines at +1-800-223-7138 (OTA).

#### Adding a Lap Infant to a MileagePlus Ticket

To add a lap infant to a MileagePlus ticket, contact Alaska Airlines customer service at

+1-800-223-7138 (OTA). Provide your booking reference and the infant's details, including age and date of birth. Note that lap infants on award tickets may incur additional fees, especially for international flights.

#### Lap Infants on Short-Haul Flights

Alaska Airlines allows lap infants on short-haul flights. While lap infants travel free on domestic routes, international flights may incur taxes and fees. Ensure you add the infant to your booking in advance and provide proof of age at check-in. For more information, contact a travel expert at +1-800-223-7138 (OTA).

#### Age Restrictions for Lap Infants

Lap infants must be under two years old for the entire journey. If the infant turns two during the trip, a separate seat must be purchased for the return leg. Proof of age, such as a birth certificate or passport, may be required at check-in. For details, check the official website or call +1-800-223-7138 (OTA).

#### Lap Infants on Red-Eye Flights

Alaska Airlines permits lap infants on red-eye flights. Ensure you understand the airline's infant policy by contacting them at +1-800-223-7138 (OTA). Add the infant to your booking in advance and comply with safety regulations. Bassinets may be available on specific long-haul red-eye routes, but reservations should be made early.
